After the death of her mother, troubled American teen Gretchen (Schafer) is forced to relocate to Bavaria with her estranged father (Marton Csokas) and his new family. In a bid to distract from her grief and homesickness, Gretchen begins working at a resort overseen by eccentric entrepreneur Herr König (Dan Stevens). When Gretchen is plagued by strange noises and disturbing visions, she suspects something isn't right in this tranquil vacation paradise. Directed with inventive flair by Tilman Singer and led by a stellar turn from Schafer, this tense and unsettling thriller will keep you guessing until the very last frame.

After 11-year-old Karin is abandoned by her father at the Sousei-Ji temple where her grandfather lives, she befriends capricious spirit animal Anzu, a Hawaiian-shirt-clad anthropomorphic cat. The pair soon develop a tight bond and travel to Tokyo in search of Karin's father. Shot live on location and rotoscoped to melt the real world into Japan's fantastical kami realm, this quirky work paints a sympathetic portrait of the less-than-perfect personalities we often encounter in life and death.

Guy Pearce, Cosmo Jarvis, and Vincent Miller star in **INSIDE**, shot entirely in Melbourne, it's a gripping portrait of institutionalisation from the local filmmaker and Short Film Palme d'Or winner Charles Williams. When Mel Blight (Miller) is transferred from juvenile detention to a maximum-security jail, he's assigned to share a cell with one of Australia's most infamous inmates, Mark Shepard (Jarvis). Seizing an opportunity, the hardened Warren Murfett (Pearce) recruits Mel to kill Mark, who has a contract on his head. As Warren nears parole and a reunion on the outside with his son, the relationship between the three men grows more entangled and intimate. Led by a trio of powerhouse performances, this is a poignant examination of the complex interplay between incarceration, rehabilitation, and remorse.

A funny, frightening, and inspirational film about the power of female friendship, this terrific film is imbued with a wicked sense of humour and exuberant hopefulness.

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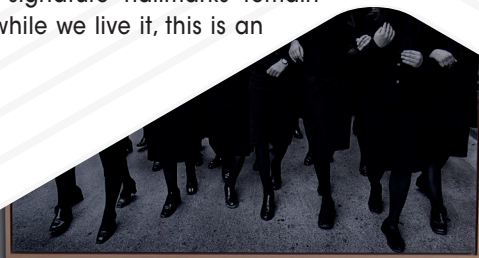
