## MAKE YOUR OWN LYLE!

All you need is a paper lunch bag (5" wide), some art supplies and your imagination to make your very own Lyle the crocodile!

Kids, get your parent's permission or supervision!

You can do this project with any crafting supplies you have at home, including:

- Markers / Crayons for coloring -

- Safety Scissors -

- Red, Green & Yellow Construction Paper -

- Glue Stick -

- Cut out or color a large green oval for Lyle's body and a slightly smaller, yellow oval for his belly.
- Cut out Lyle's head, arms, legs and tail.
- Turn your paper bag upside down so the bottom is at the top. Glue Lyle's head to the flap.
- On the main part of the bag, glue down Lyle's tail, then green body and yellow belly. Then add his arms and legs.
- Finish your creation off by coloring or cutting out 3 pieces of red paper (1 long, 2 short) to make his scarf!
